Pastor's Corner

Dear Friends in Christ, today I would like to say a few words about the Prayer Groups of San Padre Pio. When the Second World War broke out, Pope Pius XII asked for prayers to be offered for peace and unity for the salvation of the world. Padre Pio responded to the Holy Father's plea by asking all his spiritual children and the faithful who had gathered at San Giovanni Rotondo to prayer.

Padre Pio also asked people to pray for his personal intention - the Casa Sollievo della Soffrenza [the house of relief for the suffering] - a hospital that was sorely needed within the region of the Gargano in Puglia. As a result of his simple plea, many different prayer groups began to be formed throughout the world and Padre Pio decided to establish the proper functions and rules for these groups. The spiritual journey of each of the group is entrusted to the pastor of the local church with the approval of the Bishop in obedience to the Holy Father and the Church.

Our Padre Pio prayer group gathers on the third Tuesday of every month. The evening schedule begins with Holy Hour at 6:00pm, the recitation of the Holy Rosary at 6:20pm and the Eucharist at 7pm. I am asking **all parishioners** to prayerfully consider joining us on these evenings. Pax Christi, *Fv. Thomas*

Come risultato della sua semplice richiesta, iniziarono a formarsi molti gruppi di preghiera diversi in tutto il mondo e Padre Pio decise di stabilire le funzioni e le regole appropriate per questi gruppi. Il viaggio spirituale di ciascun gruppo è affidato al parroco della chiesa locale con l'approvazione del Vescovo in obbedienza al Santo Padre e alla Chiesa.

Il nostro gruppo di preghiera di Padre Pio si riunisce il terzo martedì di ogni mese. L'orario serale inizia con un'ora sacra alle 18:00, la recita del Santo Rosario alle 18:20 e l'Eucaristia alle 19:00. Chiedo a **tutti i parrocchiani** di pensare in preghiera a unirsi a noi in queste sere.

THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD



For today's Solemnity of The Epiphany of the Lord, stewardship calls us to an understanding of our Church and our faith. The Epiphany of the Lord is a vital part of our liturgical year and our Catholic tradition.

"Epiphany" literally means "becoming apparent" or "appearance." On this day we celebrate the fact that the reality of Jesus Christ as our Lord and as the divine and human Son of God becomes apparent and real to us. This manifestation, following Christmas so closely, is another reminder to us of how gifted we are. It is an additional indication to us of how essential it is for us to acknowledge our giftedness and to respond in kind through stewardship.

Many of us identify the glory and the joy of the visit of the Magi to the Christ Child, and as Isaiah the prophet envisages in today's first reading, "Then shall you be radiant at what you see; your heart shall throb and overflow, for the riches of the sea shall be emptied out before you." And we, as St. Paul indicates in the second reading, "are copartners in the promise in Christ Jesus through the Gospel."

La fermezza, la costanza, soprattutto nella fede, è impossibile senza sacrifici, ma è proprio da qui che nasce la gioia indicibile della contemplazione di Dio che si rivela a noi, così come la gioia di dare o di darsi a Dio. "Al vedere la stella, essi provarono una grandissima gioia".

Noi possiamo vedere la stella nella dottrina e nei sacramenti della Chiesa, nei segni dei tempi, nelle parole sagge e nei buoni consigli che, insieme, costituiscono la risposta alle nostre domande sulla salvezza e sul Salvatore.

Ralleghiamoci, anche noi, per il fatto che Dio, vegliando sempre, nella sua misericordia, su chi cammina guidato da una stella ci rivela in tanti modi la vera luce, il Cristo, il Re Salvatore.
