**Humanitarian Relief - Indonesia & Philippines**

On September 15, Typhoon Mangkhut struck the Philippines and killed 80 people as a result of the storm and related landslides, flash flood and destruction of homes, infrastructure and crops. Days later, on September 28, an earthquake off the coast of Sulawesi island, Indonesia, caused a tsunami with waves six meters high.

To date, more than 1700 people have been confirmed dead and more than 5000 people remain missing. In an effort to support the survivors of these two significant disasters, the Archdiocese of Toronto is accepting funds that will be sent through Caritas Internationalis, the official relief network of the Vatican. In both countries, Caritas agencies have deployed workers to provide food, drinking water, temporary shelter and medical support.

“Teacher, we want you to do for us whatever we ask of you.” We can often identify with both James and John from today’s Gospel when we directly ask God for what we want. Or perhaps we do it indirectly. We attend Mass regularly, act more obediently, and secretly hope that God is noticing and will make our requests come to fruition.

I think of how often I have treated Jesus like that one friend who people call only when they need something. Imagine if your phone rang only when people needed something from you. It would become pretty tiresome. However, Jesus does not scold his disciples, or us, for these requests. Jesus makes reference to his ultimate sacrifice. He tries to tell them that he has come to die on the cross, to pay for the sins of the world, so that we may have a loving relationship with God.

God hears all of our requests. He knows exactly what we need and when we need it. I, myself, have made some pretty steep requests, and while God might not seem to answer when I want him to, he answers when I need it. God gives me so much more than what I asked for. He gave the ultimate sacrifice of his only Son.
