How does the program work?

- Those who have been baptized but have not completed the Sacraments of Initiation (e.g. the Sacrament of First Communion and the Sacrament of Confirmation).
- Those who have been validly baptized in another Christian denomination and now wish to be received into the Catholic Church.

"Following God is not a task for the faint-hearted. The first reading and the responsorial psalm are powerful reminders of how great God is, and how wondrous are God's plans.
