JESUS IS LOOKING FOR WORKERS FOR HIS KINGDOM OF LIGHT

Jesus begins his preaching, repeating the strong admonition of John the Baptist: «Repent, because the kingdom of heaven is near". To convert means to change radically mentality, abandon the path of sin and follow the path of God. Sin enslaves and makes people live in "darkness" and "shadow of death". It is like a "yoke" that oppresses, a "bar" on the shoulders and a "stick" that beats. Jesus comes to bring the "kingdom of heaven": kingdom of "great light", of freedom and life, of joy and true gladness. For this wonderful mission of his Jesus chooses collaborators. Start calling two couples of fishing brothers. They immediately leave everything to become fishers of men. Even today, Jesus continues to call collaborators for the announcement and diffusion of the Kingdom. Trust this task specifically to bishops, priests, deacons and missionaries. However, it is a task for all the baptized, therefore yours too. The Apostle Paul suffers from divisions among Christians of Corinth. We are in the days of "prayer for Christian unity ». Pray and suffer too, so that there may be an end to division among Christians and the world believe!


