## **BAPTISM OF THE LORD**

The Holy Spirit comes to testify in a solemn way the divinity of Jesus in the moment in which he performed, like any other man, the penitential gesture, having submitted himself to the baptism of John. During his earthly life, Jesus will never show himself so great as in the humility of his gestures and words. This is an important lesson for us who see things so differently. Following Christ means taking this path of humility, that is, of truth. Christ, true God and true man, teaches us the truth of our being. Wounded by sin, purified by baptism, we oscillate between the two extremes, both attractive, of evil and holiness. And this is lived in the humblest everyday life. At every step we can choose God and his love, or, conversely, reject it. Following in the footsteps of Jesus means ensuring a path that, despite being narrow and stony, leads to eternal life, to true beatitude.


