A WORD FROM THE GOSPEL

My hour has not come, Jesus says to his Mother who, at first, seems to have been importunate saying: "They have no more wine".

The very human miracle at Cana is a miracle of Mary's faith. As it will be for the Canaanite, as it will happen for the centurion, Mary's faith obtains from the Father that Jesus anticipates the hour. And then we see the strength of the "woman" who opens here at the banquet of Cana and closes the extremes of the "now" under the cross.

The strength of faith also shines in the joy of the table master while tasting good wine: the company of God to man is very human and integral. "Not with bread alone", Jesus will say, but in the meantime he provides the diners, who cheer the spouses, with excellent wine.


ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT
