

A WORD FROM THE GOSPEL

Jesus remembers one of the fundamental components of the Christian life: being disciples. Whoever wants to lead his life alone is a blind man who leads a blind man; good fruit is found on a solid tree, and one is always bad judgment of oneself if someone does not help us. The teacher is Jesus, and we are his disciples, that is, those who allow themselves to be instructed by him, who recognize his sovereign authority and trust in his words. But blessed is he who, on earth, was able to discover the spokespersons of this authority, the masters who are not an obstacle to the only teacher, but who actualize, make concrete his word, his needs, but also his attentive love. There are teachers according to the institution, those that the Church gives us, and recognizes as such. And there are those who, hidden, allow themselves to be recognized by prepared hearts. Every man must, throughout his life, recognize himself as a disciple of Jesus: follow him, obey him and therefore listen to him, in order to put into practice his teaching that leads us to life.

MARCH 2nd (day of fasting for peace) with Ashes This 40 day period is one of the major liturgical seasons of the Catholic Church. <u>ASH WEDNESDAY MASSES</u> 9:00am - English 7:00pm - English 8:30pm - Tamil

<u>During Lent (March 2-Apr 13)</u>, on FRIDAYS (except 1st Friday of the Month) <u>NO Mass and Adoration</u> <u>(a)9am but ass ONLY at night at 7pm</u> followed by Stations of the Cross. Please come and join us.



STATIONS OF THE CROSS every Friday of Lent after 7pm mass

The Stations of the Cross, also known as the Way of the Cross and the Way of Sorrow (*Via Crucis* in Latin), detail fourteen different moments on the day Jesus died. This prayer pilgrimage is a powerful way to grow closer to Jesus at any time of the year, though it is

most popular during the Lenten season. "The cross of Christ, embraced with love, never brings sadness

with it, but joy, the joy of being saved and doing a little of what he did on the day of his death." Pope Francis
