A WORD FROM THE GOSPEL

Today's feast is intimately linked to the Resurrection. They are like two sides of the same coin. The Risen Crucifix ascends to heaven and takes our humanity to the highest possible "point", that is "to the right of the Father". The Ascension of Jesus should not be understood in a spatial sense, even if the biblical language says "lifted up ... he went away ... he was carried up to heaven". The Risen One did not turn away from his own, like a friend or family member who leaves loved ones. From that moment on they no longer see him with their own eyes, they do not converse or eat together as before. However, they have the intimate certainty that he has not gone away. In fact, waiting for the promised Spirit, they return "to Jerusalem with great joy". Entering the sanctuary of heaven, Jesus inaugurated in his blood a "new and living way". Stunning image! You now have "full freedom to enter the sanctuary ... of the house of God", following a living path: Jesus! But you must have "sincere heart", "fullness of faith" and "body washed with pure water", without wavering in the "profession of hope": one day he will return! Do you ever think about it? How will he find you? Are you waiting for him as a friend?



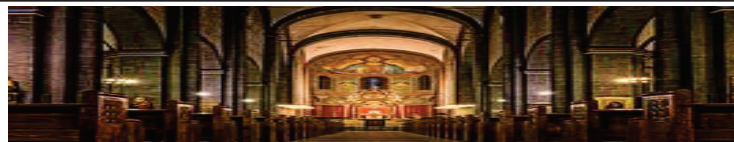
PAROLA DEL VANGELO

Il Crocifisso Risorto ascende al cielo e porta la nostra umanità al "punto" più alto possibile, cioè "alla destra del Padre". L'Ascensione di Gesù non va intesa in senso spaziale, anche se il linguaggio biblico dice "elevato in alto...se ne andava...veniva portato su, in cielo". Il Risorto non si è allontanato dai suoi, come un amico o un familiare che lascia i propri cari. Da quel momento in poi non lo vedono più con i propri occhi, non conversano né mangiano insieme come prima. Hanno però l'intima certezza che non è andato via. Difatti, in attesa dello Spirito promesso, tornano "a Gerusalemme con grande gioia". Entrando nel santuario del cielo, Gesù ha inaugurato nel suo sangue una "via nuova e vivente". Immagine stupenda! Tu ora hai la "piena libertà di entrare nel santuario...della casa di Dio", percorrendo una strada vivente: Gesù! Devi avere però "cuore sincero", "pienezza di fede" e "corpo lavato con acqua pura", senza vacillare nella "professione della speranza": un giorno egli tornerà! Ci pensi mai? Come ti troverà? Lo attendi come amico?
