TRUE WEALTH IS "WITH" THE OTHER

There is a strong contrast between what the Prophet Amos affirms, declaring that God does not forget the unjust works of those who trample the right of the poor, and the attitude of the owner of the parable narrated by Jesus, who praises his administrator despite his behavior far from exemplary. Jesus, however, he rather praises his shrewdness, inviting the disciples to live one's honesty not in a naive way, but in a "shrewd" way: the cunning consists in living not for oneself, but for others, because only through the search for their good can we achieve the happy meaning of our life. We often run this risk: to seek an honesty that remains without relationships, because she is worried about herself and her own behavior, but with a lifestyle that remains indifferent, he does not allow himself to be touched by others. The shrewdness of the administrator it consists in transforming goods into relationships, because they are friends, not possessions, to welcome us into the dwellings eternal. By caring for the good of others, and more of the good that others are, we do God's will, the which - Paul writes to Timothy - wants «that all men

Corriamo spesso questo rischio: cercare un'onestà che rimane senza relazioni, perché preoccupata di sé stessa e del proprio comportamento, ma con uno stile di vita che rimane indifferente, non si lascia toccare dagli altri. La scaltrezza dell'amministratore consiste nel trasformare i beni in relazioni, perché sono gli amici, non le ricchezze possedute, ad accoglierci nelle dimore eterne. Preoccupandoci del bene degli altri, e più ancora del bene che sono gli altri, compiamo la volontà di Dio, il quale – scrive Paolo a Timòteo – vuole «che tutti gli uomini siano salvati».
