IF WEALTH MAKES YOU BLIND

While the rich, stigmatized by Amos in the first reading, did not worry about the ruin of Joseph's house, being too busy enjoying life, filling it with goods and comforts. God is caring for his poor. The name of the poor man remembers him of Luke's parable. While, in fact, the rich man remains nameless, because of his inability to recognize the one who lies at his door makes him unknown in the eyes of God, the poor possess only the richness of a name, Lazarus, which means "God has rescued". He, wo was first thrown to the ground by indifference of most, now is welcomed in the intimacy of God, in the place of honor at the banquet of the Kingdom. An impassable abyss separates him from the rich. An abyss which was created precisely by his indifference. And it is useless that Lazarus rise from the dead to go and warn his brothers. The real sign we must see is not the risen Lazarus from the dead, but Lazarus lying in need at the door of the house. The great danger of wealth is this is more than making us bad, it makes us blind. The commandment to be kept spotless and in an irreproachable way, as Paul wrote to Timothy, it is first of all the commandment of charity.

Mentre, infatti, il ricco rimane senza nome, perché la sua incapacità di riconoscere colui che giace alla sua porta lo rende sconosciuto agli occhi di Dio, il povero possiede soltanto la ricchezza di un nome, Lazzaro, che significa «Dio ha soccorso». Egli, prima gettato a terra dall'indifferenza dei più, ora è accolto nell'intimità di Dio, al posto d'onore nel banchetto del Regno. Un abisso invalicabile lo separa dal ricco. Un abisso che è stato creato proprio dalla sua indifferenza. Ed è inutile che Lazzaro risorga dai morti per andare ad avvertire i suoi fratelli. Il vero segno che dobbiamo vedere non è Lazzaro risorto dai morti, ma Lazzaro che giace isognoso alla porta di casa. Il grande pericolo della ricchezza è questo: più che renderci cattivi, ci fa ciechi. Il comandamento da conservare senza macchia e in modo irreprensibile, come scrive Paolo a Timòteo, è anzitutto il comandamento della carità.


