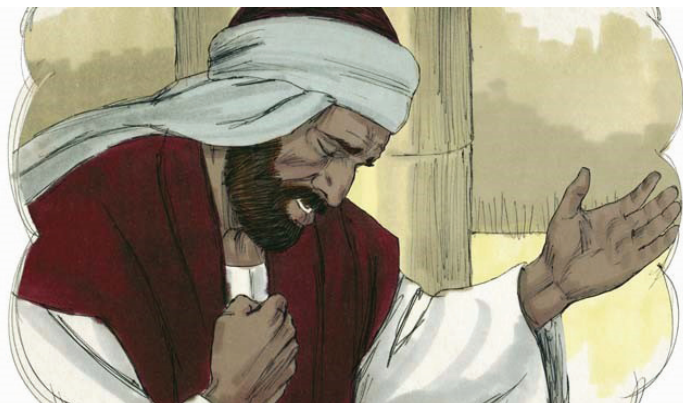

WHO HUMBLING HIMSELF WILL BE EXALTED

What happened to that tax collector who prayed at the back of the temple, "at the last pew"? The Gospel says that, unlike the Pharisee, "I go home justified". Literally: "He went down to his house ..". That is, he descended into his heart, because being before God in the truth, without mask, is like returning "home". "Man is worth as much as he is before God and no more" (St. Francis of Assisi). This is why this "sinner" teaches us the attitude of the true praying person, humility. It reminds us that we are "earth", but a blessed earth, married by Heaven, bathed in the dew of the Spirit. Only those who remain in contact with their land, only the "poor", experience the gratuitous love of God who lifts them up and does them justice. Even the apostle Paul, in the midst of trials and suffering, can feel the gracious presence of God in his life. How many missionaries and poor people in the world can testify like him: "The Lord was close to me and gave me strength".

Anche l'apostolo Paolo, in mezzo a prove e sofferenze, può sentire la benevola presenza di Dio nella sua vita. 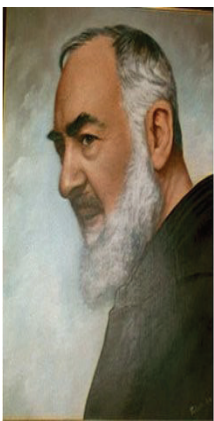
