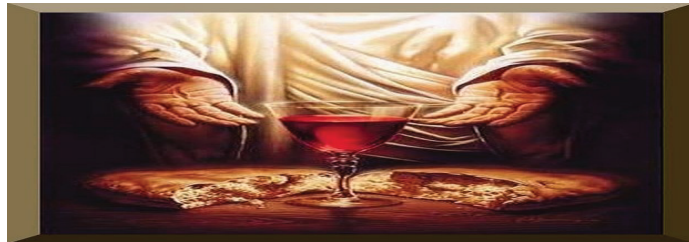
Gospel - Luke 20.27-38

A CLEAR AND BRIGHT HOPE

In the midst of so many, often painful, events of our time, the liturgy always invites us to give thanks. But thanks today goes beyond this life. It is a cry of joy because the Lord "has given us eternal consolation and good hope", a clear and luminous hope: the resurrection. In the wake of the seven young witnesses of the first covenant, we can proclaim: "From Heaven I have these members", and from the Lord I know that I will get them back again, glorified, for eternity. Truly, the Gospel is the announcement of the resurrection: "God is not of the dead, but of the living". Of course, we have respect and compassion for those who today have no hope beyond this life, but we believe more than ever that for everyone Jesus has prepared a place for eternity! We share the need for purification with other religious experiences, but we firmly reiterate that for us Christians, God is the author of salvation, it is his love that purifies us, giving us a new heart. It is this grace of his that opens us to conversion, to be children of the resurrection, children of God, "worthy of the future life and of the resurrection", in which we will be satisfied by contemplating the face of the Lord.

**UNA SPERANZA CHIARA E LUMINOSA**

In mezzo a tante vicende, spesso dolorose, del nostro tempo, la liturgia ci invita sempre al rendimento di grazie. Ma il ringraziamento oggi va oltre questa vita. È un grido di gioia perché il Signore «ci ha donato una consolazione eterna e una buona speranza», una speranza chiara e luminosa: la risurrezione. Sulla scia dei sette giovani testimoni della prima alleanza, possiamo proclamare: «Dal Cielo ho queste membra», e dal Signore so che le riavrò di nuovo, glorificate, per l'eternità. Davvero, il *Vangelo* è annuncio di risurrezione: «Dio non è dei morti, ma dei viventi». Certo, abbiamo rispetto e compassione per chi oggi non ha speranza oltre questa vita, ma crediamo più che mai che per tutti Gesù ha preparato un posto per l'eternità! Condividiamo con altre esperienze religiose la necessità di una purificazione, ma ribadiamo con fermezza che per noi cristiani è Dio l'autore della salvezza, è il suo amore che ci purifica, donandoci un cuore nuovo. È questa sua grazia che ci apre alla conversione, per essere figli della risurrezione, figli di Dio, «degni della vita futura e della risurrezione», in cui ci sazieremo contemplando il volto del Signore.

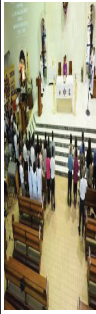
