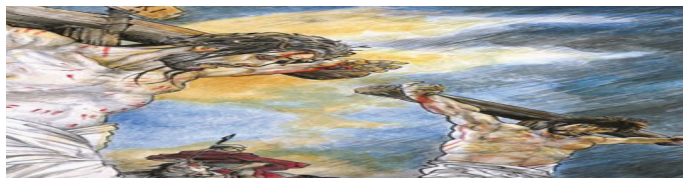
READINGS for next SUNDAY, November 20, 2022 (34, C)

PARTICIPATE IN THE FATE OF THE SAINTS IN THE LIGHT

To understand and live more intensely the meaning of today's feast, we must keep in mind the struggle that has always existed between light and darkness, grace and sin, life and death. We were all inexorably prisoners of sin and death, unable to live in peace with God, but this is no longer the case. The Father "freed us from the power of darkness and transferred us to the kingdom of the Son of his love". This marvelous work was carried out by Jesus, the "firstborn of those who rise from the dead". He fought hard, up to the cross, to obtain for us "the forgiveness of sins" and true peace with God and with our creator. On the cross, Jesus appears to be the great loser, but in reality he is "the Christ of God", the true King, like and much more than David for Israel. He immediately begins to save one of his companions in misfortune who implores with faith: "Remember me", obtaining the consoling certainty: "Today you will be with me in paradise". We too struggle every day between darkness and light. We must not fear: Jesus is with us! If we are crucified next to Jesus crucified, we know that already today, in our hearts, we can experience being in heaven with him.



PARTECIPARE ALLA SORTE DEI SANTI NELLA LUCE

Per comprendere e vivere più intensamente il significato della festa di oggi, si deve tener presente la lotta che da sempre esiste fra luce e tenebre, grazia e peccato, vita e morte. Eravamo tutti inesorabilmente prigionieri del peccato e della morte, incapaci di vivere in pace con Dio, ma adesso non è più così. Il Padre «ci ha liberati dal potere delle tenebre e ci ha trasferiti nel regno del Figlio del suo amore». Quest'opera meravigliosa è stata realizzata da Gesù, il «primogenito di quelli che risorgono dai morti». Egli ha combattuto strenuamente, fino alla croce, per ottenerci «il perdono dei peccati» e la vera pace con Dio e con il creato. Sulla croce, Gesù sembra il grande sconfitto, ma in realtà è «il Cristo di Dio», il vero Re, come e molto più di Davide per Israele. Egli inizia subito a salvare un suo compagno di sventura che implora con fede: «Ricordati di me», ottenendo la consolante certezza: «Oggi con me sarai nel paradiso». Anche noi combattiamo ogni giorno fra le tenebre e la luce. Non dobbiamo temere: Gesù è con noi! Se siamo crocifissi accanto a Gesù crocifisso, sappiamo che già oggi, nel cuore, possiamo sperimentare di essere in paradiso con lui.

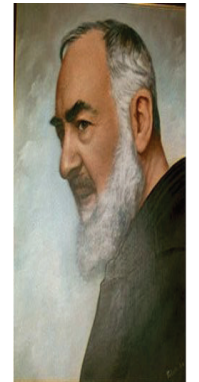
