READINGS for this SUNDAY, November 27, 2022 (1 Advent, A)

1st Reading - Isaiah 2.1-5
2nd Reading - Romans 13.11-14
Gospel - Matthew 24.37-44

A TIME TO START AGAIN

The Lord warns us to be ready, to be vigilant; he will come suddenly. These are challenging words that invite to conversion, but also consoling, because they remind us that our life, is never abandoned to nonsense, is oriented towards the Kingdom, it is waiting for the Lord who is coming, it is salvation that is approaching. Let us therefore decide for God, no matter in what situation we meet. Salvation is offered to all and Paul tells us how to take advantage of it: wake up from sleep, cast off the works of darkness and put on the armor of light. We acknowledge our sin and welcome God's forgiveness. Wars will continue and evil will seem to run rampant, because the devil always wants to destroy God's creation. But where men and women say "yes" to God, swords and spears will be broken and plowshares and sickles will be made of them. Instruments of war and death will become instruments of peace and life. Where there was hatred, love will spread. It is the essential dimension of our faith: the ability to always regenerate. In Advent, we are given a time to start over. In God's hands we are regenerated, to regenerate the world and history.

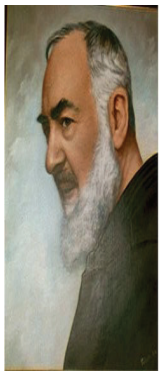

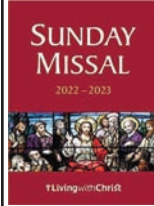

Focus briefly on this evocative theme of "waiting", for it touches upon a profoundly human aspect in which the faith becomes, so to speak, completely one with our flesh and our heart.
