READINGS for this SUNDAY, December 4, 2022 (2 Advent A)

1st Reading - Isaiah 11.1 - 10 2nd Reading - Romans 15.4 - 9 Gospel - Matthew 3.1 - 12

PREPARE THE WAY OF THE LORD, STRAIGHTEN HIS TRAILS

The Messiah will come to sow true peace, not just any pacifism. Rich in the "Spirit of the Lord", he will take care of the poor and the oppressed and will bring reconciliation even between natural enemies, such as wolf and lamb, but he will violently strike the wicked until he kills him "with the breath of his lips". So proclaimed the ancient prophet Isaiah. The prophet John the Baptist understood this truth well. In the desert of Judea, on the banks of the Jordan, he took the people and invited them to conversion: "Prepare the way of the Lord, straighten his paths". Loud as thunder must have been his voice and maybe even rough, a bit like the dress he wore and the food he ate. He wanted to awaken consciences asleep in Pharisees and in the external observance of the Law. His baptism «in the water for the conversion" was only a prelude to the great gift that the Messiah would have given with baptism "in the Holy Spirit and fire". And you, now? We too to bear "good fruit" and to be "wheat in God's barn", we must welcome our brothers and sisters with love, as Christ welcomes each one of us. This is the only way we can celebrate Christmas!
