THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT

READINGS for this SUNDAY, December 11, 2022 (3 Advent A)

1st Reading - Isaiah 35.1 - 6a, 10

2nd Reading - James 5.7 - 10

Gospel - Matthew 11.2 - 11

LET US GO WITH JOY TO MEET THE LORD

This Sunday's liturgical readings underline the dual character of Advent, which intends to prepare us both for the historic coming of the Son of God and for his coming at the end of time. The saving work of the Son of God, overshadowed by the prophet Isaia in the festive images of Israel's return from Babylonian slavery, lives on in the Gospel passage as a loving presence, which frees from evil and heals, enlivens and gladdens. The prophecy is fulfilled in Jesus: this the envoys must report to John the Baptist, confirming the solidity of his work as a forerunner. Now that the good news runs towards the prison in which John is locked up, Jesus praises it. His austere figure, his clear and upright behavior, his radical and audacious words are known to people, but John is more, for his unique mission to prepare consciences to welcome the Messiah. The apostle James instead dwells on the second coming of the Lord as the irrevocable horizon of earthly existence. With calm words, he repeatedly exhorts us to keep waiting for the Lord, persevering in doing good with firmness of mind and serene trust.

Le letture liturgiche di questa domenica sottolineano il duplice carattere dell'Avvento, che intende predisporci sia alla venuta storica del Figlio di Dio, sia alla sua venuta alla fine dei tempi. L'opera salvifica del Figlio di Dio, adombrata dal profeta Isaia nelle immagini festose del ritorno d'Israele dalla schiavitù babilonese, vive nella pagina evangelica come presenza amorevole, che libera dal male e risana, vivifica e allietta. La profezia si compie in Gesù: questo gli inviati devono riferire a Giovanni Battista, a conferma della solidità del suo operato di precursore. Ora che la bella notizia corre verso il carcere in cui Giovanni è rinchiuso, Gesù ne tesse l'elogio. La sua figura austera, il suo comportamento limpido e retto, le sue parole radicali e audaci sono note alla gente, ma Giovanni è di più, per la sua missione unica di preparare le coscienze ad accogliere il Messia. L'apostolo Giacomo si sofferma, invece, sulla seconda venuta del Signore come orizzonte irrevocabile dell'esistenza terrena. Con parole pacate, egli esorta ripetutamente a tener desta l'attesa del Signore, perseverando nel bene con fermezza d'animo e serena fiducia.

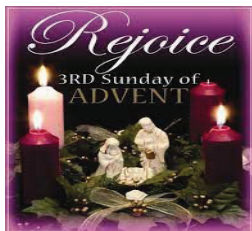


Society of St. Vincent de Paul

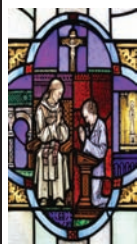

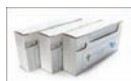
