

READINGS for this SUNDAY, December 18, 2022 (4 Advent A)

1st Reading - Isaiah 7.10 - 14 2nd Reading - Romans 1.1 - 7 Gospel - Matthew 1.18 - 24

ON THE THRESHOLD OF THE MYSTERY

In the run-up to Christmas, the readings of this last Sunday of Advent lead us to the threshold of the mystery of the Incarnation, announced for centuries and which is now fulfilled. they suggest us to contemplate, pause to meditate on the making of the divine plan in history, which goes beyond the slothful disbelief of King Ahaz; an arcane and surprising plot, woven of fragile flesh and divine goodness, whose name is Jesus, true and true man God. The Holy Spirit is the weaver and the divine hand who forms the "God with us" in the womb of the Virgin. He has Joseph, the husband of Mary, to welcome the divine will and to be guardian of the child to be born, dressed in divinity, which absent eyes cannot intuit, but simple faith can humble. The prophetic word of Isaia is substantiated in truth and in the flesh; the Son of God takes over our history; divine design comes to fulfillment. The Gospel page, which this gives us a glimpse of, it stops on the threshold of the mystery and exalts its waiting to tell us that in the trembling heart of Mary, the woman of the free and fruitful "yes", and Joseph, troubled and docile, everything is ready to welcome Jesus... And us?
