READINGS for SUNDAY, Jan. 15 (2ND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME)

1st Reading - Isaiah 49.3, 5 - 6 2nd Reading - 1 Corinthians 1.1 - 3 Gospel - John 1.29 - 34

JESUS REVELATOR OF THE FATHER'S LOVE

Isaìa, the prophet, has developed a fundamental certainty: his mission as a "servant" cannot be limited to the people alone of Israel. Jahvè will make him «light of the nations» to bring the salvation "to the ends of the earth". The last and more great of the prophets, John the Baptist, sees Jesus coming and presents him as "the lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world". What is this sin? It is the refusal to acknowledge the "man" Jesus of Nazareth as Messiah and Son of God! It's the continuation struggle between darkness and Light, a struggle that will mark the whole Gospel and marks the life of every human being, including mine and the your! Illuminated by intimacy with God, the Baptist contemplates the Spirit which, "like a dove", "descends" and "remains" on Jesus. The Trinity makes itself present for the first time in history of humanity. The new times have now begun: Jesus, who "baptizes in the Holy Spirit", brings fullness to the whole world of God's love. The Apostle Paul knows well this saving truth. Therefore he addresses himself to «all those who in every place they call upon the name» of Jesus we who, with baptism, are "saints by calling".
