LUCKY YOU!

ALREADY NOW, LIVING THE PROMISED JOY

In the first beatitude, which we hear today in the Gospel, "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven", we find the central and summarizing backbone of the liturgical proposal of this Sunday, because such bliss echoes in the other readings today, especially in the Responsorial Psalm, which is a moving celebration of God's goodness mainly towards the poor and abandoned. We cannot forget, however, that the poverty mentioned in Scripture is not just about size sociological, despite its importance, but assumes, above all, a spiritual dimension, that is, that of the total abandonment in God, of the sincere search for his will, to defer to his judgment, the only truthful and merciful one, because only God knows and scrutinizes the thoughts of the heart. The Beatitudes are first and foremost a representation of person and of the very life of God, as one is fully manifested in Jesus Christ; and they are offered by him to his disciples, and therefore also to us, because we can always look alike more to him, so as to really correspond to that image and likeness with which we came out of the creative hands of God.



<u>BEATI VOI!</u> <u>VIVERE GIÀ ORA LA GIOIA PROMESSA</u>

Nella prima beatitudine, che ascoltiamo oggi nel Vangelo, «Beati i poveri in spirito, perché di essi è il regno dei cieli», troviamo il nerbo centrale e riassuntivo della proposta liturgica di questa domenica, perché tale beatitudine riecheggia nelle altre letture odierne, soprattutto nel Salmo responsoriale, che è una commossa celebrazione della bontà di Dio verso i più poveri e abbandonati. Non possiamo dimenticare, però, che la povertà di cui parla la Scrittura non riguarda solo la dimensione sociologica, pur nella sua importanza, ma assume anche, e soprattutto, una dimensione spirituale, quella cioè del totale abbandono in Dio, della ricerca sincera della sua volontà, del rimettersi al suo giudizio, il solo veritiero e misericordioso, perché solo Dio conosce e scruta i pensieri del cuore. Le beatitudini sono anzitutto una rappresentazione della persona e della vita stessa di Dio, come si è compiutamente manifestata in Gesù Cristo; e sono da lui proposte ai discepoli, e quindi anche a noi, perché possiamo rassomigliare sempre più a lui, così da essere davvero corrispondenti a quell'immagine e somiglianza con cui siamo usciti dalle mani creative di Dio.


