LET YOUR LIGHT SHINE BEFORE MEN

A few weeks ago (III Sunday of Ordinary Time), the Gospel presented us with the theme of light, identifying it in Christ, whose preaching illuminates the regions of the soul "immersed in the darkness" of error (cf. Mt 4:12-16). Today, according to the Gospel word, it is the disciples themselves who become «light of world"! As happens in a crystal prism, in which the only white light of the sun is decomposed into various shades of colors, like this is to the Christian: drawing on the unique eternal splendor of God, in his life he is called to be a reflection of it according to his abilities and the talents that the Lord Himself has placed in him. Thus, in a backward journey, the whole community of the Church can recompose that bright white that, even second philosophy, paradoxically is the summary of all colors. Very high vocation, great commitment, but at the same time extremely exciting, because we know that only light and strength of the Word of God can give authentic flavor to life... like salt, drawing from it day after day in sufficient quantities and indispensable for walking in the deserts of life by making them flourish of goodness and holiness.


