READINGS for SUNDAY, Feb. 26 (1st Sunday of Lent)

1st Reading - Genesis 2.7 - 9, 16 - 18, 25; 3.1 - 7 2nd Reading - Romans 5.12 - 19 Gospel - Matthew 4.1 - 11

BE GUIDED BY THE WORD

Lent is a time of trial and discernment. It leads us towards Easter asking ourselves the question: who do we want to be? We want to look like the first Adam or the new Adam, Jesus Christ? Adam, put to the test, yields to temptation and disobevs the Word of God. The new Adam conquers the tempter because he keeps the Word of God in his heart, and the Word is it guards in the filial relationship with the Father. Jesus is and remains a son because he responds to every temptation by letting himself be guided by Scriptures and opposing the word of the divider to that of the Father, that does not separate, but creates communion. Here's how to live well the path towards Easter: listening to the Word of God, meditating on it and pray, so as to make light for our steps, a lamp on the walk. The Word of God also makes us a great promise, like Paul announces to the Romans: if for the fall of a single man humanity is condemned, for the righteous work of one man God's justice is poured out on all of us, which gives us life. The path of Lent must therefore be lived in the joy of one who knows – this is how he makes us pray Psalm 50 – that one's heart has been recreated by the mercy of God



GUIDATI DALLA PAROLA

Gesù è e rimane figlio perché a ogni tentazione risponde lasciandosi guidare dalle Scritture e opponendo alla parola del divisore quella del Padre, che non separa, ma crea comunione. Ecco come vivere bene il cammino verso la Pasqua: ascoltare la Parola di Dio, meditarla e pregarla, così da renderla luce per i nostri passi, lampada sul cammino. La Parola di Dio ci fa anche una grande promessa, come Paolo annuncia ai Romani: se per la caduta di un solo uomo si è riversata sull'umanità la condanna, per l'opera giusta di un solo uomo si riversa su tutti noi la giustizia di Dio, che ci dà vita. Il cammino quaresimale va perciò vissuto nella gioia di chi sa - così ci fa pregare il Salmo 50 – che il proprio cuore è stato ricreato dalla misericordia di Dio.


