

## <u>CHRIST JESUS,</u> HEALING AND LIGHT OF MEN

The election of David and his anointing as king of Israel reminds us that in baptism we too were chosen by God and clothed with royal dignity. Baptism is also called "illumination", because it places the baptized in the realm of light, as occurs in the healing of man blind from birth. Light is the first reality created by God. And God shares it with us, his children, because we manifest it with the testimony of our lives: «Now you are light in the Lord: behave as children of the light". Baptism is considered a new creation: Jesus who make's mud and spreads it on the eyes of the blind man two symbolic baptismal gestures that bring us back to the first creation, that of man shaped by dust/mud of the soil (cf. Gen 1:27; 2:7). Even for us every Sunday Jesus prepares that miraculous mud which is his Word, which heals us and enlightens us. For us too he renews the gestures of today our bap-tism, opening our ears and our eyes with the gift of a new light.

L'elezione di Davide e la sua unzione a re d'Israele ci ricordano che nel battesimo anche noi siamo stati scelti da Dio e rivestiti della dignità regale. Il battesimo è chiamato anche "illuminazione", perché colloca il battezzato nell'ambito della luce, come avviene nella guarigione dell'uomo cieco fin dalla nascita. La luce è la prima realtà creata da Dio. E Dio la partecipa a noi suoi figli perché la manifestiamo con la testimonianza della nostra vita: «Ora siete luce nel Signore: comportatevi come figli della luce». Il battesimo è considerato una nuova creazione: Gesù che fa del fango e lo spalma sugli occhi del cieco compie due gesti battesimali simbolici che ci riportano alla prima creazione, quella dell'uomo plasmato dalla polvere/fango del suolo (cf. Gen 1,27; 2,7). Anche per noi ogni domenica Gesù prepara quel fango miracoloso che è la sua Parola, che ci guarisce e ci illumina. Anche per noi rinnova oggi i gesti del nostro battesimo, aprendo i nostri orecchi e i nostri occhi con il dono di una nuova luce.


# EARTHQUAKE IN TURKEY & SYRIA HUMANITARIAN RELIEF

### MESSAGE OF HIS HOLINESS POPE FRANCIS FOR LENT 2023

LENT is a special time for prayer, penance, reflection, service /charity and reconciliation.

**Every Friday of Lent, Mass will be celebrated at 9:00am and 7:00pm with the STATIONS OF THE CROSS** The disciples' experience on Mount Tabor was further enriched when, alongside the transfigured Jesus, Moses and Elijah appeared, signifying respec-



tively the Law and the Prophets (cf. *Mt* 17:3). The newness of Christ is at the same time the fulfilment of the ancient covenant and promises; it is inseparable from God's history with his people and discloses its deeper meaning. In a similar way, the synodal journey is rooted in the Church's tradition and at the same time open to newness. Tradition is a source of inspiration for seeking new paths and for avoiding the opposed temptations of immobility and improvised experimentation.

L'esperienza dei discepoli sul Monte Tabor si arricchisce ulteriormente quando, accanto a Gesù trasfigurato, appaiono Mosè ed Elia, che impersonano rispettivamente la Legge e i Profeti (cfr Mt 17,3). La novità del Cristo è compimento dell'antica Alleanza e delle promesse; è inseparabile dalla storia di Dio con il suo popolo e ne rivela il senso profondo. Analogamente, il percorso sinodale è radicato nella tradizione della Chiesa e al tempo stesso aperto verso la novità. La tradizione è fonte di ispirazione per cercare strade nuove, evitando le opposte tentazioni dell'immobilismo e della sperimentazione improvvisata.
