READINGS for SUNDAY, April 16 (2nd SUNDAY OF EASTER - DIVINE MERCY)

1st Reading - Acts 2.42 - 47 2nd Reading - 1 PETER 1.3 - 9 Gospel - John 20.19 - 31

TO THE SOURCES OF SALVATION

Generated by the breath of the Spirit, we have entered the eighth day, Eternity. The liturgy today refers us to the profound meaning of our Baptism, making us draw from the springs of Easter which flowed from Christ's passion, death and resurrection. It's an immersion in life! With the apostle Thomas we celebrate our "second birth": we are born to the faith because we are regenerated by the "great mercy" of the Father and, participating in this gift, we discover together the Body of Christ, his Church, a community of the saved, sent to bring salvation in the world in need of reconciliation. In the body of the risen Lord we find imprinted the signs of our wounded humanity, which he bears upon himself. Love has not erased them, but redeemed them; he made them "sacrament of salvation", so that through them they continue to pour torrents of mercy into us. The baptismal resurrection does not take us away from the daily effort of believing but, through the various trials of life, it regenerates us "for a living hope": our inheritance of loved and forgiven children who now confess, even without seeing: "My Lord and my God!"




