READINGS for SUNDAY, May 7, (5th SUNDAY OF EASTER)

1st Reading - Acts 6.1 - 7 2nd Reading - 1 PETER 2.4 - 9 Gospel - John 14.1 - 12

<u>JESUS IS THE WAY, THE TRUTH AND THE LIFE</u>

Today the Gospel takes us to the Last Supper. The Paschal Supper is over and Judas has gone out into the night. Jesus converses with his disciples because he has to communicate truths that have not yet been revealed. It is a conversation not only from Master to disciples, but from Friend to friends, indeed from family intimacy. A veil of sadness reigns in the group, because Jesus has said that he is about to leave. He encourages them not to be upset: he will never be able to abandon them, even if he is about to "go to the Father". Thomas raises an objection and Jesus makes himself known as the only way that leads to truth and give life. Then, in the sweet and strong rebuke to Philip, he affirms something humanly unheard of, dizzying in faith: "Whoever has seen me has seen the Father". God and man are united in the person of Jesus. He is true God and true man! Our faith rests on this mystery. Jesus, the "living stone", has chosen us "as living stones" to build the "spiritual building" of his Church. With baptism we are all called to exercise a holy priesthood, "to offer spiritual sacrifices to God" and proclaim his wonderful works, spreading the Word that leads to faith.

Egli è vero Dio e vero uomo! La nostra fede poggia su guesto mistero. Gesù, "pietra viva", ci ha scelti "quali pietre vive" per costruire "l"edificio spirituale" della sua Chiesa. Con il battesimo tutti siamo chiamati a esercitare un sacerdozio santo, "per offrire sacrifici spirituali graditi a Dio" e proclamare le sue opere meravigliose, difondendo la Parola che conduce alla fede.




