READINGS for SUNDAY, September 17

(24th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME)

1st Reading - Sirach 27.30 - 28.7

2nd Reading - Romans 14.7 - 9

Gospel - Mathew 18.21 - 35

MERCIFUL BECAUSE GOD DOES THIS

"Whoever retains anger towards another man, how can he ask the Lord for healing?". If God, great and magnanimous, welcomes our pleas and forgives those who have offended us, we too must show pity and mercy towards our brothers, even if they are guilty towards us. Saint Paul offers a strong reason for forgiveness of offenses: with the Risen One we form one body, so we no longer live for ourselves but for the Lord to whom we belong. Like him, we too must know how to live and die for our brothers. To Peter who asks the Lord if he must forgive only up to seven times, Jesus replies: "Up to seventy times seven". The characteristics of Christian forgiveness are those of forgiving everyone without distinction, always and in all circumstances. If we forgive only those for whom it is convenient, because they are stronger than us or necessary to us, we are not on the trail of true forgiveness. The person who owed ten thousand talents is all of us, who misuse the gifts that God bestows upon us. If he continues to believe in us, we too must give credit to the other. We therefore do not forgive because we expect repentance, but because God does so.

Il tale che aveva un debito di diecimila talenti siamo tutti noi, che usiamo male i doni che Dio ci elargisce. Se lui continua a credere in noi, anche noi dobbiamo dare credito all'altro. Non perdoniamo allora perché ci aspettiamo un ravvedimento, ma perché Dio fa così.

YOUTH MINISTRY COLLECTION

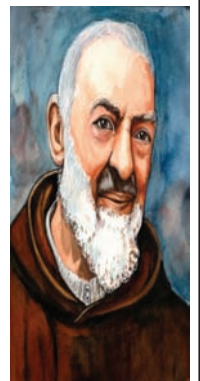
TODAY, September 17th there will be a collection for the Youth Ministry.
