

#### THE LORD VISITS HIS VINEYARD

The recurring image in the liturgy of the Word this Sunday is that of the vineyard. Every winemaker knows that the vine is that of the vineyard. Every winemaker knows that the vine is an extremely delicate shrub, in need of a lot of care: it doesn't take much to ruin the efforts made and not obtain the desired fruit. It is the image that the Bible prefers to identify the people of Israel, custodians of infinite care from God, yet always very fragile; thus Jesus also seems to indicate the new Israel, his Church, for which he gave his life in preaching, in kindness towards suffering, in forgiveness and acceptance. Often, it must be recognized, the Lord did not obtain the desired fruit of his labors, up to his death on the cross. The conclusion should be that of final ruin: this is how we men reason. Instead, Jesus reminds us that the stone rejected by the builders became the cornerstone; the Lord works wonders and his love will always overcome any human failure. All this invites us to give thanks today: we are often weak in faith and humanity, but nothing is lost in Christ, because we are helped by his mercy and providence.

Spesse volte, va riconosciuto, il Signore non ha ottenuto il frutto desiderato delle sue fatiche, fino alla morte in croce. La conclusione dovrebbe essere quella della rovina finale: così ragioniamo noi uomini. Invece Gesù ricorda che la pietra scartata dai cosgtruttori è divenuta pietra angolare; il Signore compie meraviglie e il suo amore supererà sempre qualsiasi fallimento umano. Tutto ciò ci invita oggi al rendimento di grazie: siamo spesso deboli in fede e umanità, ma nulla in Cristo va perduto, perché siamo soccorsi dalla sua misericordia e dalla sua provvidenza.




