1st Reading - Exodus 22.21 - 27

2nd Reading - 1 Thessalonians 1.5c - 10

Gospel - Mathew 22.34 - 40

THE GREAT COMMANDMENT

To the doctor of the Law who questions him about the "great commandment", Jesus replies that the primacy of love belongs to God, but immediately adds that there is another "similar" commandment, which is love of neighbour. He bases his response on the authority of Scripture and at the same time establishes the necessary connection between the two commandments: the measure of God's love is the "all" and engages the believer in the richness of his potential; the measure of love of neighbour is the empathy of charity, which pours the "all" of the love given to God into concrete actions inspired by justice. Love is the fullness of the Law and is the key to understanding it; it is the criterion that must guide every action and the end to which it must aim. Love inspires the creativity of those who love; it keeps the mind pure, the gaze clear, the heart compassionate. For those who serve the living and true God with an upright conscience nothing is unbecoming and everything is good. A community, which accepts the "effort of charity" and expresses itself in the service of God and others, is firm in faith and consistent with the word of the Lord, and has the fragrance of the Gospel.

**IL GRANDE COMANDAMENTO**

Al dottore della Legge che lo interroga sul "grande comandamento", Gesù risponde che il primato dell'amore appartiene a Dio, ma subito aggiunge che c'è un altro comandamento "simile", che è l'amore del prossimo. Fonda la sua risposta sull'autorità della Scrittura e al contempo sancisce il nesso necessario che intercorre tra i due comandamenti: la misura dell'amore di Dio è il "tutto" e impegna il credente nella ricchezza delle sue potenzialità; la misura dell'amore del prossimo è l'empatia della carità, che riversa in azioni concrete e ispirate a giustizia il "tutto" dell'amore dato a Dio. L'amore è la pienezza della Legge ed è la chiave per comprenderla; è il criterio che deve orientare ogni azione e il fine a cui deve tendere. L'amore ispira la creatività di chi ama; mantiene pura la mente, limpido lo sguardo, compassionevole il cuore. Per chi serve il Dio vivo e vero con retta coscienza nulla è disdicevole e tutto è buono. Una comunità, che accetta la "fatica della carità" ed esprime sé stessa nel servizio di Dio e del prossimo, è salda nella fede e coerente con la parola del Signore, e ha la fragranza del Vangelo.

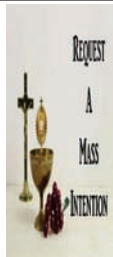

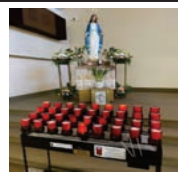
