

1st Reading - Job 7.1 - 4, 6 - 7 2nd Reading - 1 Corinthians 9.16 - 19, 22 - 23 Gospel - Mark 1.29 - 39

THE LORD HEALS THE BROKEN HEARTS

Job only needs a few brush strokes to describe his state of mind. The night of pain is dark and troubled, woven of illusions and worries; the thread of hope is exhausted. He will have to bow to the mystery of God. The greatness of the Almighty will be amaze him and will understand that it is not the foolishness of words but adoring silence befits his presence. In Capernaum Jesus meets suffering humanity. For the wounded in body and spirit he is consolation and hope. He approaches with his unmistakable style, as he does with the mother-in-law of Simon Pietro: he takes her pain upon himself and heals her. «He is burdened with our sufferings, he took on our pains", says the Prophet (Is 53.4). Jesus does not explain suffering, but fills them with his presence. In the morning prayer, done in solitude, he retraces the intense day spent amongst the people on the way out of the synagogue; he sees the faces again, he thinks back to the questions and anxieties. In intimacy he declares himself to the Father, then he sets out towards an "elsewhere" waiting to be evangelized. St. Paul, following the Master's example, will derive the urgency of "doing everything for everyone"



IL SIGNORE RISANA I CUORI AFFRANTI

A Giobbe bastano poche pennellate per descrivere il suo stato d'animo. La notte del dolore è cupa e tribolata, intessuta di illusioni e affanni; il filo della speranza è esaurito. Egli dovrà inchinarsi al mistero di Dio. La grandezza dell'Onnipotente lo stupirà e capirà che non la stoltezza delle parole ma il silenzio adorante s'addice al suo cospetto. A Cafarnao Gesù incontra l'umanità sofferente. Per i piagati nel corpo e nello spirito egli è consolazione e speranza. Li accosta con il suo stile inconfondibile, come fa con la suocera di Simon Pietro: prende su di sé il suo dolore e la risana. «Egli si è caricato delle nostre sofferenze, si è addossato i nostri dolori», dice il Profeta (Is 53,4). Gesù non spiega la sofferenza, ma la riempie della sua presenza. Nella preghiera del mattino, fatta in solitudine, egli ripercorre l'intensa giornata vissuta fra la gente all'uscita della sinagoga; rivede i volti, ripensa alle domande e alle angosce. Nell'intimità si dichiara al Padre, poi s'incammina verso un "altrove" che attende di essere evangelizzato. San Paolo, sull'esempio del Maestro, ne ricaverà l'urgenza di "farsi tutto per tutti".

A CELEBRATION OF MARRIAGE ARCHDIOCESE OF TORONTO This Sunday FEBRUARY 11, 2024


