

READINGS for SUNDAY, Mar. 3rd (3rd SUNDAY of LENT, Year B)

1st Reading - Exodus 20.1 - 17 2nd Reading - 1 Corinthians 1.18, 22 - 25 Gospel - John 2.13 - 25

FILIAL FREEDOM

We encounter a third place on our Lenten itinerary: where we were with Jesus in the desert, we climbed Tabor with him, now we enter with him into the temple of Jerusalem. Through the gestures and words he pronounces, Jesus makes us understand that entering the true temple means entering in him, in his person, in his filial way of being in relationship with his Father. We are tempted to turn God into a merchant by bargaining with him for what we need. Jesus reminds us that God is a Father, who wishes to share his life and joy with us. This filial attitude must nourish our ways to obey the commandments, as revealed to Moses. It's not about living a mercantile observance to obtain some grace or benefit in exchange, but to safeguard the gift of filial freedom that God has offered us freely in Jesus' Easter, of which Moses' Passover is prophecy. In this is the wisdom and power of the cross that Paul announces: in the death and resurrection of Jesus; God has made us his children, capable of living a free relationship with him, knowing that he knows well what is in the heart of each one of us.



<u>LIBERTÀ FILIALE</u>

Un terzo luogo incontriamo nel nostro itinerario quaresimale: siamo stati con Gesù nel deserto, siamo saliti con lui sul Tabor, ora entriamo con lui nel tempio di Gerusalemme. Attraverso i gesti che compie e le parole che pronuncia, Gesù ci fa capire che entrare nel vero tempio significa entrare in lui, nella sua persona, nel suo modo filiale di essere in relazione con il Padre. Noi siamo tentati di trasformare Dio in un mercante, contrattando con lui ciò di cui abbiamo bisogno. Gesù ci ricorda che Dio è un Padre, che desidera condividere con noi la sua vita e la sua gioia. Questo atteggiamento filiale deve nutrire anche il nostro modo di obbedire ai comandamenti, rivelati a Mosè. Non si tratta di vivere un'osservanza mercantile per ottenere in cambio qualche beneficio o qualche grazia, ma di custodire il dono della libertà filiale che Dio ci ha offerto gratuitamente nella Pasqua di Gesù, di cui la Pasqua di Mosè è profezia. Ecco la sapienza e la potenza della croce che Paolo annuncia: nella morte e nella risurrezione di Gesù; Dio ci ha resi suoi figli, capaci di vivere con lui un rapporto libero e gratuito, sapendo che egli conosce bene quello che c'è nel cuore di ciascuno.


