


1st Reading - 2 Chronicles 36.14 - 17a, 19 - 23 2nd Reading - Ephesians 2.4 - 10 Gospel - John 3.14 - 21

BY GRACE WE HAVE BEEN SAVED

«What a Lenten look!» is the motto on the lips of many when you find yourself in front of a person with a frowning face, sad, almost tending towards depression. A way of saying that it comes from an incorrect conception of Lent, understood as a time of desolation and sadness. In reality, it rather refers to seriousness, determination, in alignment towards an important achievement, which has nothing to do with the sadness to oneself or discouragement; instead it calls for the determined face of Jesus on his way to Jerusalem. This is why, to remind us of this truth, the liturgy intervenes, in the middle of the Lenten journey, with "Laetare" Sunday, the Sunday that invites us to joy, because God calls us with Christ to the resurrection and shows us his extraordinary richness of grace. Turn your gaze to Christ, as in the past the people of Israel faced that serpent raised in the desert, it means reminding us of the destination of our life, which is certainly passing through the crash of death, but turns towards the light of the resurrection.

Un modo di dire che deriva da una concezione errata di Quaresima, intesa come un tempo di desolazione e tristezza. In realtà essa richiama piuttosto alla serietà, alla determinazione, al chiaro orientamento verso un ottenimento importante, che nulla ha a che vedere con la mestizia fine a sé stessa e con lo sconforto; richiama invece alla determinazione del volto di Gesù in cammino verso Gerusalemme. Ecco perché, a richiamarci questa verità, la liturgia interviene, nel mezzo del cammino quaresimale, con la domenica "Laetare", la domenica che ci invita alla gioia, perché Dio con Cristo ci chiama alla risurrezione e ci manifesta la sua straordinaria ricchezza di grazia. Volgere lo sguardo a Cristo, come un tempo il popolo d'Israele faceva verso quel serpente innalzato nel deserto, significa richiamarci la destinazione della nostra vita, che passa certamente attraverso lo schianto della morte, ma volge verso la luce della risurrezione.
