THE COURAGE TO SHOUT FOR LIFE

After the destruction of Jerusalem (587 A.C.), during the exile, the prophet Jeremiah intoned the first notes of a melody full of hope, inviting the "rest of Israel" (the blind, the lame...) to sing with joy of the salvation promised by the Lord. Are there still those who, in the darkness, know how to "shout" their hope? How many screams remain buried under the blanket of pain! How many more are dispersed in voiceless sounds of sterile complaints! But this blind man's cry, named Bartimeo, breaks the sound barrier with interior disarming clarity. Bartimeo introduces the strategy more ingenious than his creativity suggests: he *shouts*, he has nothing else. He doesn't shout something, but he shouts at *Someone*. This cry has the faith of those who, in pain, remain tenaciously in contact with their own desire of life and pours it into a relationship: his cry of faith is the "prayer of the heart" that launches into the heart of Jesus. As a "compassionate priest" Jesus takes charge, to the point of bringing him to the Father, with the voice of his own humanity, on the altar of the cross. Today he is here, in this Eucharist, to bring him ours too.



IL CORAGGIO DI GRIDARE LA VITA

Dopo la distruzione di Gerusalemme (587 A.C.), durante l'esilio, il profeta Geremia intonava le prime note di una melodia colma di speranza, invitando il "resto d'Israele" (il cieco, lo zoppo...) a cantare sin da allora la gioia della salvezza promessa dal Signore. C'è ancora chi, nel buio, sa "gridare" la propria speranza? Quante grida restano sepolte sotto la coltre del dolore! Quante altre si disperdono in suoni afoni di sterili lamentele! Ma il grido di quest'uomo cieco, di nome Bartimeo, infrange la barriera del suono con una limpidezza interiore disarmante. Bartimeo introduce la strategia più geniale che la sua creatività gli lascia intuire: lui grida, non ha altro. Non grida qualcosa, ma grida a qualcuno. Questo grido ha la fede di chi, nel dolore, rimane tenacemente a contatto col proprio desiderio di vita e lo riversa in una relazione: il suo grido di fede è la "preghiera del cuore" che si lancia nel cuore di Gesù. Come "sacerdote compassionevole" Gesù se ne fa carico, al punto da portarlo al Padre, con la voce della sua stessa umanità, sull'altare della croce. Oggi è qui, in questa Eucaristia, per portargli anche il nostro.

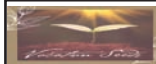
