


SHE GAVE MORE THAN ALL THE OTHERS

Today, two poor widows are the protagonists of the liturgy of Word. The widow of Sarepta, choosing to give food to the prophet, shows great faith. Preparing the focaccia first for the man of God and then for herself and her son, putting God first. Her faith is rewarded because «the flour in the jar did not empty out and the jar of oil did not decrease." The widow of the Gospel, although she donates much less money than all the others, she does not deprive herself of the superfluous but of all that she has: she simply trusts in God and waits from his support and salvation. The woman is praised by Jesus because she is certain that the true treasure, that moth and rust does not consume (Mt 6.19), is the relationship with the Lord that is possible only by making her own self-giving choices. Our donation is pleasing to the Lord if we are willing to "leave" something important, to give up and offer our renunciation up to God like he did. Sublime model of donation is, in fact, the Lord Jesus who offered himself, sacrificing himself for us as a true paschal lamb.



<u>HA DATO PIÙ DI TUTTI GLI ALTRI</u>

Due povere vedove sono oggi le protagoniste della liturgia della Parola. La vedova di Sarepta, scegliendo di dare da mangiare al profeta, dimostra una grande fede. Preparando prima la focaccia per l'uomo di Dio e poi per sé stessa e per il figlio, mette Dio al primo posto. La sua fede viene premiata perché «la farina della giara non venne meno e l'orcio dell'olio non diminuì». La vedova del Vangelo, sebbene doni una somma di denaro molto inferiore a tutti gli altri, non si priva del superfluo ma di tutto quello che ha: confida semplicemente in Dio e attende da lui sostegno e salvezza. La donna è lodata da Gesù perché ella è certa che il vero tesoro, che tarma e ruggine non consumano (Mt 6,19), è la relazione con il Signore che si può realizzare solo facendo le sue stesse scelte di autodonazione. La nostra donazione è gradita al Signore se siamo disposti a "lasciare" qualcosa di importante, a rinunciare e a offrire la nostra rinuncia a Dio come ha fatto lui. Modello sublime di donazione è, infatti, il Signore Gesù che ha offerto sé stesso, immolandosi per noi quale vero agnello pasquale.
