1st Reading - Isaiah 40.1-5, 9-11 2nd Reading - Titus 2.11-14; 3.4-7 Gospel - Luke 3.15-16, 21-22


MARKED WITH THE INDELIBLE SEAL OF <u>CHRIST</u>

Jesus is the "good news", which the prophet Isaiah announces covertly. He is the Expected One, the meek and patient shepherd, that consoles and frees, that speaks to the heart and guides with tenderness. On the banks of the Jordan the people await Christ. The words of John the Baptist have awakened dormant consciences and the need for purification. Jesus, the innocent, shows up to receive baptism; he blends in with the people and takes charge of the sinful situation of the people. The sky, closed by guilt of Adam, opens: he is the new Adam who brings the world back to God; the Spirit descends and remains on him: he is the Anointed of the Lord, the awaited Messiah, who fulfills the promises; the voice from above proclaims the identity of the Son: he is the Beloved forever. Meanwhile Jesus prays: found his public life and his saving mission, that baptism inaugurates, on humble and total fidelity to the Father. In this fidelity, which is a prelude to the cross, our baptism is inscribed. Regenerated in the water and in the Spirit, baptismal grace enables us to live a true life of the Gospel. Mark yourself with the indelible seal of Christ, we are his forever.
