YOUR GOD WILL REJOICE OVER YOU

The bright future of Jerusalem, foretold by Isaiah, will be revealed with the fulfillment of the messianic promises. The silence of God and the desolation due to his absence will cease; Sion will once again experience the thrill of spousal intimacy with her husband God, evoked by the royal symbols of loyalty and belonging; God will be pleased with her and the people will see her glory. The words of the Prophet will come true in Jesus, the Word made flesh to reconcile with God humanity wounded by sin. His first public release the day after the baptism on the banks of the Jordan, happens in the wedding of Cana, which conceals hidden meanings. "Jesus manifested his glory", comments the evangelist, after having described the wonder-sign of water changed into wine. The ordeal shines through in the "sign" of Cana. The discreet intervention of the mother of Jesus prepares with trust and hope for the hour of salvation, in which the innocent blood of the Son will fill with grace humanity. Jesus is the epiphany of God. His message beautifies the heart of those who taste the new, transforming wine of faith; of those who guard the amphora of the Spirit and pours out its gifts.

Cesserà il silenzio di Dio e la desolazione per la sua assenza; Sion proverà di nuovo l'ebbrezza dell'intimità sponsale con il suo Dio, evocata dai simboli regali della fedeltà e dell'appartenenza; Dio si compiacerà di lei e le genti vedranno la sua gloria. Le parole del Profeta si inverano in Gesù, il Verbo fatto carne per riconciliare con Dio l'umanità ferita dal peccato. La sua prima uscita pubblica all'indomani del battesimo sulle rive del Giordano, accade nel contesto nuziale di Cana, che cela significati reconditi. «Gesù manifestò la sua gloria», chiosa l'evangelista, dopo aver descritto il segno-prodigio dell'acqua cambiata in vino. Nel "segno" di Cana traspare il Calvario. L'intervento discreto della madre di Gesù prepara nella fiducia e nella speranza l'ora della salvezza, in cui il sangue innocente del Figlio colmerà di grazia l'umanità. Gesù è l'epifania di Dio. Il suo messaggio fa bello il cuore di chi assapora il vino nuovo, trasformante, della fede; di chi custodisce l'anfora dello Spirito e ne riversa i doni.

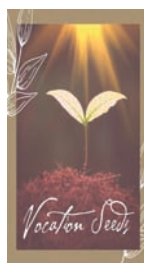

MESSAGE OF POPE FRANCIS
PILGRIMS OF HOPE / *Pellegrini di Speranza*

In our day too, the Jubilee is an event that inspires us to seek to establish the liberating justice of God in our world. In place of the ram's horn, at the start of this Year of Grace we wish to hear the "desperate plea for help" that, like the cry of the blood of Abel, rises up from so many parts of our world – a plea that God never fails to hear. We for our part feel bound to cry out and denounce the many situations in which the earth is exploited and our neighbours oppressed. These injustices can appear at times in the form of what [Saint John Paul II](#) called "structures of sin", that arise not only from injustice on the part of some but are also consolidated and maintained by a network of complicity.

Al posto del corno, all'inizio di quest'Anno di Grazia, noi vorremmo metterci in ascolto del «grido disperato di aiuto» che, come la voce del sangue di Abele il giusto, si leva da più parti della terra e che Dio non smette mai di ascoltare. A nostra volta ci sentiamo chiamati a farci voce di tante situazioni di sfruttamento della terra e di oppressione del prossimo. Tali ingiustizie assumono a volte l'aspetto di quelle che S. Giovanni Paolo II definì «strutture di peccato», poiché non sono dovute soltanto all'iniquità di alcuni, ma si sono per così dire consolidate e si reggono su una complicità estesa.

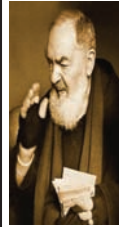
