READINGS for SUNDAY, Jan. 26th (3rd SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME)

1st Reading - Nehemiah 8.2-4a, 5-6, 8-10 2nd Reading - 1 Corinthians 12.12-30 Gospel - Luke 1.1-4; 4.14-21

RELIGIOUSLY LISTENING TO THE WORD OF GOD

Today, "religious listening" characterizes, in a particular way, the Universal Church and our Sunday assembly. Let's celebrate the annual "Sunday of the Word of God". Let's bring attention to the Holy Book, the norm of life for every Christian; we welcome it in faith, «not as the word of man but, truly, as the word of God, which works in the believers." Today's readings teach us. The solemn ceremonial reading of the book of the Law of God before the people of Israel. Great veneration, intense and devoted listening, leading to emotion, for the Law rediscovered" after the long Babylonian exile; the readers guide the understanding of the assembly by chanting the text and explaining it; people identify with the event and body gestures express the common feeling. It's the day of the "great God", to be lived in brotherhood, with joy and gratitude, and in a renewed "Amen" to his Law. In the synagogue of Nazareth Jesus declares that the Scriptures are fulfilled in him. He is the eternal "today" of God in history. His words are spirit and life: in him, Word made flesh, everything lives, everything is true, everything is grace.

4. Each of us must feel in some way responsible for the devastation to which the earth, our common home, has been subjected, beginning with those actions that, albeit only indirectly, fuel the conflicts that presently plague our human family. I think, in particular, of all manner of disparities, the inhuman treatment meted out to migrants, environmental decay, the confusion willfully created by disinformation, the refusal to engage in any form of dialogue and the immense resources spent on the industry of war. All these, taken together, represent a threat to the existence of humanity as a whole. At the beginning of this year, then, we desire to heed the plea of suffering humankind in order to feel called, together and as individuals, to break the bonds of injustice and to proclaim God's justice. Cultural and structural changes are necessary. so that enduring change may come about.
