1st Reading - Isaiah 6.1-2A, 3-8 2nd Reading - 1 Corinthians 15.1-11 Gospel - Luke 5.1-11

#### «HERE I AM, SEND ME!»


The story of Isaiah's vocation - a prophet who lived eight centuries before Christ - is set in a bright and solemn setting of the temple, where the holiness and glory of God shine ("Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts! The whole earth is full of his glory"). The prophet recognizes his unworthiness in the face of the call which he received ("A man of impure lips am I"). But God places a very small word on his lips ("Here I am"), but full of effectiveness ("Send me!"). Simon Peter's call is placed within the framework of a fisherman's daily life, which flows on Lake Tiberias. After one night of work and failure. ("We worked hard all night and we didn't take anything») Jesus intervenes with prodigious effectiveness of his word ("Put out into the deep and cast your nets for a catch") and with the promise of transforming the work of a fisherman on Lake Tiberias in the mission to bring salvation to that lake from now going forward, it will be the world of men ("Do not be afraid; from now on you will be a fisherman of men"). It is the salvation announced by Paul, by the apostles and today by the Church.



# «ECCOMI, MANDA ME!»

Il racconto della vocazione di Isaia – un profeta vissuto otto secoli prima di Cristo – è ambientato nella cornice luminosa e solenne del tempio, dove risplendono la santità e la gloria di Dio («Santo, santo, santo il Signore degli eserciti! Tutta la terra è piena della sua gloria»). Il profeta riconosce la propria indegnità di fronte alla chiamata che ha ricevuto («Un uomo dalle labbra impure io sono»). Ma Dio gli pone su queste stesse labbra una parola piccola piccola ("Eccomi"), ma ricca di efficacia ("Manda me!"). La chiamata di Simon Pietro si colloca nella cornice della vita quotidiana di pescatore, che scorre sul lago di Tiberiade. Dopo una notte di fatica e di insuccesso («Abbiamo faticato tutta la notte e non abbiamo preso nulla») interviene Gesù con l'efficacia prodigiosa della sua parola («Prendi il largo e gettate le reti per la pesca») e con la promessa di trasformare il lavoro di pescatore sul lago di Tiberiade nella missione di portare la salvezza a quel lago che d'ora in poi sarà il mondo degli uomini («Non temere; d'ora in poi sarai pescatore di uomini»). È la salvezza annunciata da Paolo, dagli apostoli e oggi dalla Chiesa.

#### **JUBILEE YEAR 2025 MESSAGE OF POPE FRANCIS** PILGRIMS OF HOPE/Pellegrini di Speranza

5. The celebration of the Jubilee spurs us to make a number of changes in order to confront the present state of injustice and inequality by reminding ourselves that the goods of the earth are meant not for a privileged few, but for everyone. We do well to recall the words of Saint Basil of Caesarea: "Tell me, what things belong to you? Where did you find them to make them part of your life? ... Did you not come forth naked from the womb of your mother? Will you not return naked to the ground? Where did your property come from? If you say that it comes to you naturally by luck, you would deny God by not recognizing the Creator and being grateful to the Giver". Without gratitude, we are unable to recognize God's gifts. Yet in his infinite mercy the Lord does not abandon sinful humanity, but instead reaffirms his *gift* of life by the saving forgiveness offered to all through Jesus Christ. That is why, in teaching us the "Our Father", Jesus told us to pray: "Forgive us our trespasses" (Mt 6:12).

5. L'evento giubilare ci invita a intraprendere diversi cambiamenti, per affrontare l'attuale condizione di ingiustizia e diseguaglianza, ricordandoci che i beni della terra sono destinati non solo ad alcuni privilegiati, ma a tutti. Può essere utile ricordare quanto scriveva S. Basilio di Cesarea: «Ma quali cose, dimmi, sono tue? Da dove le hai prese per inserirle nella tua vita? [...] Non sei uscito totalmente nudo dal ventre di tua madre? Non ritornerai, di nuovo, nudo nella terra? Da dove ti proviene quello che hai adesso? Se tu dicessi che ti deriva dal caso, negheresti Dio, non riconoscendo il Creatore e non saresti riconoscente al Donatore». Quando la gratitudine viene meno, l'uomo non riconosce più i doni di Dio. Nella sua misericordia infinita, però, il Signore non abbandona gli uomini che peccano contro di Lui: conferma piuttosto il dono della vita con il perdono della salvezza, offerto a tutti mediante Gesù Cristo. Perciò, insegnandoci il "Padre nostro", Gesù ci invita a chiedere: «Rimetti a noi i nostri debiti» (Mt 6,12).
