READINGS for t SUNDAY, Feb. 16th (6th SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME)

1st Reading - Jeremiah 17.5 - 8 2nd Reading - 1 Corinthians 15.12, 16 - 20 Gospel - Luke 6.17, 20 - 26

BLESSED IS HE WHO TRUSTS IN THE LORD

Jesus' preaching, which today concerns the "Beatitudes", is prepared from the words of the biblical prophets. They present the curse as the word of failure: «Cursed is the man who trust in man." The blessing, on the other hand, places man within the scope of God, who guides and protects him: «Blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord." The evangelist Luke sets the teaching of Jesus on the Beatitudes «in a level place», while Matthew has them proclaimed "on the mountain". However, both catch the eye of Jesus facing a humanity wounded by suffering, poverty, injustice, persecution and discrimination. The "trouble" that introduce the four curses pronounced by Jesus ("Trouble to you who are rich, to you who are full, to you who laugh, to you whom everyone talks good"), they are, yes, a condemnation, but above all they are a strong appeal to conversion, to sharing goods and to bend down as good Samaritans on the poor, suffering and alone. Today welcome this appeal, to become a witness to the Beatitudes in your family, the environment you work in and the community of faith that embraces you every Sunday with the gift of peace.



BENEDETTO CHI CONFIDA NEL SIGNORE

La predicazione di Gesù, che oggi riguarda le "Beatitudini", è preparata dalle parole dei profeti biblici. Essi presentano la maledizione come la parola del fallimento: «Maledetto l'uomo che confida nell'uomo». La benedizione invece colloca l'uomo nell'ambito di Dio, che lo guida e lo protegge: «Benedetto l'uomo che confida nel Signore». L'evangelista Luca ambienta l'insegnamento di Gesù sulle Beatitudini «in un luogo pianeggiante», mentre Matteo le fa proclamare «sul monte». Entrambi però colgono lo sguardo di Gesù rivolto a un'umanità ferita dalle sofferenze, dalla povertà, dall'ingiustizia, dalle persecuzioni e discriminazioni. I "guai" che introducono le quattro maledizioni pronunciate da Gesù («Guai a voi ricchi, a voi sazi, a voi che ridete, a voi di cui tutti parlano bene»), sono, sì, una condanna, ma soprattutto sono un forte appello alla conversione, alla condivisione dei beni e al chinarsi come buoni samaritani sul prossimo povero, sofferente e solo. Oggi accogli anche tu questo appello, per diventare testimone delle beatitudini nella tua famiglia, nell'ambiente in cui lavori e nella comunità di fede che ogni domenica ti abbraccia con il dono della pace.

6. Once we lose sight of our relationship to the Father, we begin to cherish the illusion that our relationships with others can be governed by a logic of exploitation and oppression, where might makes right. Like the elites at the time of Jesus, who profited from the suffering of the poor, so today, in our interconnected global village, the international system, unless it is inspired by a spirit of solidarity and interdependence, gives rise to injustices, aggravated by corruption, which leave the poorer countries trapped. A mentality that exploits the indebted can serve as a shorthand description of the present "debt crisis" that weighs upon a number of countries, above all in the global South.

6. 
