# **THE BREATH OF FORGIVENESS AND NEW LIFE**

The activity of the apostles is presented in continuity with that of Jesus, who entrusts them with his own mission of announcing the Gospel and performing healings: «Many miracles were performed among the people through the apostles». The book of Revelation (a term that means "revelation") describes the reassuring presence of Jesus in the midst of his community gathered "on the Lord's day" (Sunday) to listen to his word of hope that supports them in facing persecution: «Do not be afraid!» It is on Sunday that Jesus comes among us and shows – as to the incredulous Thomas – "his hands and his side", that is, the "signs" and "places" of his passion, the source of our salvation and the revelation of his mercy. The "breath" of Jesus who gives the Spirit («He blew and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit"»), recalls the breath of God in creation, when he gives life to man («He blew into his nostrils and man became a living being»: Gen 2,7). With his Easter, Jesus gives all of us a new life, marked by the breath of the forgiveness of sins and the breath of the gratuitousness of his mercy.



# IL SOFFIO DEL PERDONO E DELLA VITA NUOVA

L'attività degli apostoli viene presentata in continuità con quella di Gesù, che affida loro la stessa sua missione di annunciare il Vangelo e di operare guarigioni: «Molti prodigi avvenivano fra il popolo per mezzo degli apostoli». Il libro dell'Apocalisse (termine che significa "rivelazione") descrive la presenza rassicurante di Gesù in mezzo alla sua comunità radunata "nel giorno del Signore" (la domenica) per ascoltare la sua parola di speranza che la sostiene nell'affrontare la persecuzione: «Non temete!» È nella domenica che Gesù viene in mezzo a noi e mostra – come all'incredulo Tommaso – "le sue mani e il suo fianco", cioè i "segni" e i "luoghi" della sua passione, fonte della nostra salvezza e rivelazione della sua misericordia. Il "soffio" di Gesù che dona lo Spirito («Soffiò e disse loro: "Ricevete lo Spirito Santo"»), ricorda il soffio di Dio nella creazione, quando dona la vita all'uomo («Soffiò nelle sue narici e l'uomo divenne un essere vivente»: Gen 2,7). Con la sua Pasqua Gesù dona a tutti noi una nuova vita, segnata dal soffio del perdono dei peccati e dal soffio della gratuità della sua misericordia.

# **TODAY= DIVINE MERCY PRAYER**

The devotion was actively promoted by Pope John Paul II. On April 30, 2000 the Canonization of Faustina Kowalska took place and the second Sunday of Easter was officially designated as the Sunday of the Divine Mercy (Dominica II Paschae seu de divina misericordia) in the General Roman Calendar. On April 22, 2001, which was one year after establishing Divine Mercy Sunday. Pope John Paul II re-emphasized its message in the resurrection context of Easter: Jesus said to Sr Faustina: "Humanity will never find peace until it turns with trust to Divine Mercy". This is the Easter gift that the Church receives from the risen Christ and offers to humanity.
