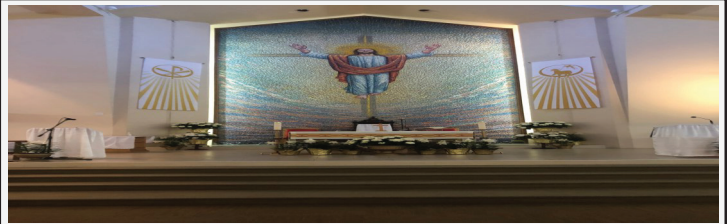
«IT IS THE LORD!»

«Jesus revealed himself again to the disciples... and he revealed himself like this...». He does not “appear” but reveals himself like this, imbued with the colors of our days. “Easter” is the story of a loving encounter that carries within it the new presence of the risen Lord in the lives of the disciples, as in ours. Every day he comes to meet us where we are, even in the darkness of a night of toil spent at sea without catching anything. Hadn’t this been the place for Peter’s “first appointment”, where the encounter with Jesus had given a new meaning to his life? The presence of the Risen One in the everyday life made of lights and shadows does not impose itself, but offers itself delicately to the gaze of our faith, just like the beloved who seeks the eyes of his beloved, waiting to be recognized by her: «It is the Lord!». He makes himself recognizable in the small gestures of love, in the new yet ancient flavor of the fish and the carefully prepared bread, as if to tell us again that inside every night is enclosed the dawn of resurrection. His voice, that morning by the sea, brought a familiar invitation: «Come and eat»; the same one that he still addresses to us today at the Eucharistic table.

Ogni giorno lui viene a incontrarci là dove siamo, fin nel buio di una notte di fatica passata in mare senza prendere nulla. Non era stato questo per Pietro il luogo del “primo appuntamento”, dove l’incontro con Gesù aveva dato un senso nuovo alla sua vita? La presenza del Risorto nella ferialità fatta di luci e ombre non s’imponde, ma si offre delicatamente allo sguardo della nostra fede, proprio come fa l’amato che va in cerca degli occhi dell’amata, attendendo di essere da lei riconosciuto: «È il Signore!». Si fa riconoscere nei piccoli gesti d’amore, nel sapore nuovo eppure antico del pesce e del pane preparato con cura, come a volerci ridire che dentro ogni notte è racchiusa l’alba di risurrezione. La sua voce, quel mattino in riva al mare, recava un invito familiare: «Venite a mangiare»; lo stesso che oggi ancora rivolge a noi alla mensa eucaristica.

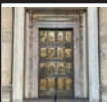
**CELEBRATING MOTHER MARY
