(BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST)

1st Reading - Genesis 14.18 - 20
 2nd Reading - 1 Corinthians 11.23 - 26
 Gospel - Luke 9.11b - 17

EVERYONE ATE THEIR FULLNESS

Satisfying the hunger of the people, the object of Jesus' care, is not just a bread that was enough for everyone, until there was some left over. What really satisfies is the way in which it was offered. At its origin is the "little" that is shared, placing one's trust in God, who makes even our limitations, if lived in a logic of giving and fraternal sharing, capable of satisfying everyone's hunger. Then, there is a personal care and responsibility to live. To the disciples, who would like everyone to make do as they can, Jesus says that they must personally commit themselves: «You yourselves give them something to eat». What feeds others is not so much the bread we offer, but the relational proximity with which we take charge of their needs. In this style, the mystery of the Eucharist, a real sign of the Body and Blood of Christ, already shines through. He even makes the extreme limit, which is death, a gift to share, offering his life for the life of all. And we, eating his bread, are called to do it in his memory. Our whole life must remember what we celebrate, through the gestures of sharing and care that we can experience every day.

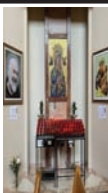
