MESSENGERS OF HOPE

The invitation to hope by the prophet Isaiah is a stupendous vision of humanity advancing, even through struggles and difficulties, toward a destiny of glory and peace. It was the hope that he intended to instill in the lost hearts of his compatriots to invite them to trust only in God, to whom everything is possible. In the Gospel, it is Jesus who sends the sowers of hope. The Lord could, without a doubt, do everything but, in fact, he asks for our co-responsibility and calls, precisely, each of us to be an artisan of hope. As he did to the seventy-two, so too to us Jesus gives his advice for the mission: to be animated not by a spirit of domination and conquest, but by gentleness and peace: it is a question of finding the way of the heart to open it to the Gospel, with the means of simplicity and essentiality, without any recourse to impressive works, and to entrust only to God the success of our labor. To be messengers of hope: why? Because the world in which we live is full of violence, fear, isolation, lack of ideals. Only the message of Christ and his "messengers" can respond to these anguished expectations and give light, liberation and salvation.

Solo il messaggio di Cristo e dei suoi "messaggeri" può rispondere a queste attese angosciose e donare luce, liberazione e salvezza.
