
PERSEVERING IN FAITH

A theme emerges today: perseverance. Moses perseveres in prayer, aided by Aaron and Hur, who support his hands raised to God in intercession for Israel. Perseverance is not a solitary attitude, but a communal one. We support one another, together. Writing to Timothy, Paul highlights another necessary perseverance: listening to the Word of God assiduously, since it is the Scriptures that instruct us for salvation, "which comes through faith in Jesus Christ." Finally, the parable tells of the persevering and tenacious widow who, thanks to her persistence, obtains justice even from an unjust judge. The final question continues to challenge us, asking us to deepen our look: "But when the Son of Man comes, will he find faith on earth?" The real problem is faith. The absolutely necessary perseverance is that of faith, because all other perseverances of which we must be capable are anchored on it. Having faith also means this: remaining steadfast in hope when the wait seems long, sometimes too long.



PERSEVERARE NELLA FEDE

Un tema emerge oggi: la perseveranza. Mosè persevera nella preghiera, aiutato da Aronne e da Cur, che sostengono le sue mani alzate verso Dio nell'intercessione per Israele. La perseveranza non è un atteggiamento solitario, ma comunitario. Ci si sostiene a vicenda, gli uni gli altri, insieme. Scrivendo a Timoteo, Paolo evidenzia un'altra perseveranza necessaria: ascoltare la Parola di Dio con assiduità, poiché sono le Scritture a istruirci per la salvezza, "che si ottiene mediante la fede in Cristo Gesù", Infine, la parabola narra della vedova perseverante e tenace che, grazie alla sua insistenza, ottiene giustizia persino da un giudice disonesto. La domanda finale continua a interrogarci chiedendoci di approfondire lo sguardo: "Ma il Figlio dell'uomo, quando verrà, troverà la fede sulla terra?'. ll vero problema è la fede. La perseveranza assolutamente necessaria è quella della fede, perchè su di essa si ancorano tutte le altre perseveranze di cui dobbiamo essere capaci. Avere fede significa anche questo: rimanere stabili nella speranza quando I'attesa sembra farsi lunga, a volte troppo lunga.


