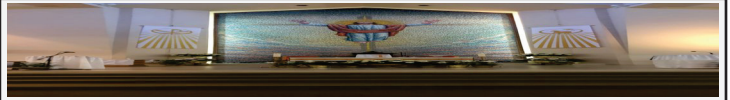

PEACEFUL, IN THE HANDS OF GOD

In the chaotic landscape of human history, there are those who ferment war and terror, and those who continue to repeat with patient love: "Do not be afraid!" The peace of heart, so desired by each of us, lies not in the absence of trials or tribulations, but in the awareness of always and in every circumstance being protected by that God who cares about even the smallest hair on our head. God does not remove us from difficulties, but holds us in his hands. This is the profound truth that the Gospel delivers to us as it announces the events that precede "the end." Jesus does not call us to immerse ourselves in an indefinite future ("when?..."), but in the real time we inhabit, the only time in which we are given to live actively and bear witness to our faith. "Do not prepare your defense first" What else is that, if not a disarmament in the face of evil, exposing ourselves to others as we are, fragile and vulnerable? Humanity awaits the testimony of an unarmed and disarming love. Then "the day is coming, burning like an oven" when all the evil present in human hearts will burn away, but "for you" who fear God, "for you" who persevere, it will be like the beneficial warmth of the sun's rays when it caresses your face.

**SERENI, NELLE MANI DI DIO**

Nello scenario caotico della storia umana c'è chi fomenta guerra e terrore, e chi continua a ripetere con amore paziente: «Non abbiate paura!». La serenità del cuore, tanto desiderata da ciascuno di noi, non risiede nell'assenza di prove o tribolazioni, ma nella consapevolezza di essere sempre e in ogni circostanza custoditi da quel Dio a cui sta a cuore persino il più piccolo capello del nostro capo. Dio non ci sottrae dalle difficoltà, ma ci tiene nelle sue mani. È la profonda verità che il Vangelo ci consegna mentre annuncia gli eventi che precedono "la fine". Gesù non ci chiama a calarci in un futuro indefinito («quando? ...»), ma nel tempo reale che abitiamo, l'unico in cui ci è dato di vivere operosamente e testimoniare la nostra fede. Quel «non preparate prima la vostra difesa» cos'altro è se non un disarmo di fronte al male, e esporci agli altri così come siamo, fragili e vulnerabili? L'umanità attende la testimonianza di un amore disarmato e disarmante. Ecco allora «venire il giorno rovente come un forno» in cui brucerà tutto il male presente nel cuore degli uomini, ma «per voi» che temete Dio, «per voi» che perseverate sarà come il calore benefico dei raggi del sole quando accarezza il volto.

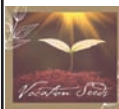

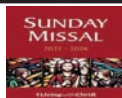
