READINGS for SUNDAY, Dec. 7th (SECOND SUNDAY OF ADVENT)

1st Reading - Isaiah 11.1 - 10 2nd Reading - Romans 15.4 - 9 Gospel - Matthew 3.1 - 12

WELCOME OURSELVES TO WELCOME GOD

We experience Advent with the desire to welcome the coming of the Lord. Writing to the Romans, Saint Paul reminds us that welcoming Christ means welcoming one another. The images of peace suggested to us by the prophet Isaiah, making us contemplate the wolf dwelling with the lamb, while the leopard lies down beside the kid, urge us to experience paths of reconciliation between us men and women. Often, we are a wolf to someone else, or we perceive the threat of someone who appears to us with the face and aggression of a young lion. The conversion to which John the Baptist invites us has a double dimension, both vertical and horizontal. We convert to God if we do so towards one another. If God can raise up children of Abraham even from stones, he can make us brothers and sisters despite our hard, petrified hearts. Fruitless trees are thrown into the fire. Yet, John announces that Jesus will come with a different fire, that of the Holy Spirit, to burn away everything in us that resists the filial acceptance of God, the fraternal acceptance of others.

Se Dio può suscitare figli di Abramo anche dalle pietre, può renderci fratelli e sorelle nonostante il nostro cuore duro, come fosse pietrificato. Gli alberi senza frutto vengono gettati nel fuoco. Eppure, Giovanni annuncia che Gesù verrà con un fuoco diverso, quello dello Spirito Santo, per bruciare tutto ciò che in noi pone resistenza all'accoglienza filiale di Dio, all'accoglienza fraterna degli altri.


