BEHOLD THE LAMB OF GOD

After the Christmas season, which presented Jesus to us in the weakness of childhood, the Church helps us understand that the one who came for us is our Redeemer. The words of Isaiah recognize the Messiah's mission to bring salvation to the ends of the earth. Jesus is the Savior, the "light of the nations" and the center of history that we must welcome if we do not want to reap the bitter and unpleasant fruits of disorder, unhappiness, and sorrow. John the Baptist points him out to his disciples, indicating him as the Lamb of God, the true Lamb who, through his death, will bring about redemption for all humanity. He invites them to follow him because the Holy Spirit has descended upon him, a sign that he recognized him as sent by God. It is he who takes away the sin of the world; that is, he is the one who with his freedom offers himself as a sacrifice so that every man may be freed from sin: distance from God, self-sufficiency, and spiritual blindness. Whoever, with Christ, conquers sin finds grace and peace in the Lord, and becomes a saint by calling to bring love, joy, and justice to the world and to his brothers and sisters.

Giovanni Battista lo addita ai suoi discepoli indicandolo come l'agnello di Dio, il vero agnello che con la sua morte realizzerà la redenzione per tutta l'umanità, e invita a seguirlo perché su di lui è sceso lo Spirito Santo segno dal quale lo ha riconosciuto come mandato da Dio. È lui che toglie il peccato del mondo, è cioè colui che con la sua libertà si offre in sacrificio perché ogni uomo sia liberato dal peccato: la lontananza da Dio, l'autosufficienza e la cecità spirituale. Chi, con Cristo, vince il peccato trova grazia e pace nel Signore, e diventa santo per chiamata per portare l'amore, la gioia e la giustizia al mondo e ai fratelli.
