A LIGHT SHINES ON OUR DARKNESS

"Repent!" This is Jesus' first word at the beginning of his ministry in Galilee. Why convert? "Because the Kingdom has come near!" Because an extraordinary gift of God is offered to us in the person of Jesus. Like Saint Paul, we need to convert, to embrace the newness of the Gospel. Conversion is not a thing of the past reserved for a few famous saints like Augustine: it is our common calling today. To convert means to welcome the victory of "Midian" in our life, that is, the victory of God, the victory of light over the hidden darkness of our hearts. Because there is a "Galilee" within us that awaits the light of Christ! What will be the fruit of conversion? It is to become a community with other brothers and sisters. Conversion occurs in the "union of thought and feeling" that Paul recommends to the Christians of Corinth, never again allowing ourselves to cultivate divisions and resentments. Today, Jesus passes by the shore of our lives and calls us to follow him together with other brothers and sisters. Will we leave our nets to follow him together with others?

Perché c'è in noi una "Galilea" che aspetta la luce di Cristo! Quale sarà il frutto della conversione? È il divenire comunità con gli altri fratelli e sorelle. La conversione si verifica nella "unione di pensiero e di sentire" che Paolo raccomanda ai cristiani di Corinto, nel non permetterci mai più di coltivare divisioni e rancori. Oggi, Gesù passa sulla riva della nostra vita e ci chiama a seguirlo insieme ad altri fratelli e sorelle. Lasciamo le nostre reti per seguirlo insieme ad altri?
