

1st Reading - Sirach 15.15 - 20
 2nd Reading - 1 Corinthians 2.6 - 10
 Gospel - Matthew 5.17 - 37

JESUS CAME TO FULFIL

The only law that challenges every conscience and holds it accountable before God and others is love. The love that Jesus speaks of is not pure sentiment, but rather feeling responsible for the good and happiness of oneself and others. Love without rules, following instinct, without the "law," at first glance seems completely free, but it only brings unhappiness because it feeds only one's own selfishness. The love that Jesus asks for, he lived on the cross, giving his all. Love, which is the full fulfillment of the law and which gives happiness and fullness of life, is not the satisfaction of one's own needs, but is the fruit of the love of God that the Lord has poured into our hearts. For this reason, the Gospel indicates six instances of daily life in which the disciple is asked to make choices of true and courageous love: they concern the themes of reconciliation, anger, insult, adultery, distancing ourselves from sin, and divorce. The Book of Sirach tells us that the commandments are not a cage, but the way to be kept in goodness and to know the true wisdom revealed by God through the Spirit.

**GESÙ È VENUTO PER DARE COMPIMENTO**

La sola legge che interpella ogni coscienza e la rende responsabile di fronte a Dio e agli altri è l'amore. L'amore di cui parla Gesù non è puro sentimento, ma è sentirsi responsabili del bene e della felicità propria e altrui. L'amore senza una regola, seguendo l'istinto, senza la "legge" appunto, a prima vista sembra pienamente libero, ma porta solo infelicità perché nutre unicamente il proprio egoismo. L'amore che chiede Gesù, lui l'ha vissuto sulla croce, dando tutto sé stesso. L'amore, che è pieno compimento della legge e che dona la felicità e la pienezza della vita, non è soddisfacimento dei propri bisogni, ma è frutto dell'amore di Dio che il Signore ha effuso nei nostri cuori. Per questo il Vangelo indica sei casi della vita quotidiana nei quali viene chiesto al discepolo di fare scelte di amore vero e coraggioso: essi riguardano i temi della riconciliazione, della rabbia, dell'insulto, dell'adulterio, della distanza dal peccato, del divorzio. Il Libro del Siracide ci dice che i comandamenti non sono una gabbia, ma il modo per essere custoditi nel bene e conoscere la vera sapienza rivelata da Dio per mezzo dello Spirito.




**FAMILY DAY


