READINGS for SUNDAY, April 12th

(2ND SUNDAY OF EASTER or DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY)

1st Reading - Acts 2.42 - 47

2nd Reading - 1 Peter 1.3 - 9

Gospel - John 20.19 - 31

A SHARED FAITH

"You love him, though you have not seen him; and now, though you do not see him, you believe in him." What Peter writes in his first letter exhorts each of us to live the blessedness of faith that the Risen One proclaims after being recognized by Thomas: "Blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed." Thomas demands to see personally because he does not trust the testimony of others and of the community. He did not believe the word of Mary Magdalene. His absence on the first day of the week attests to this: he is not with the other apostles because he did not accept Mary's message. Likewise, he does not believe what his companions told him. There is an imperfect verb here to underline the insistence with which the other disciples announced their encounter with the Risen One, as well as Thomas's stubbornness in not believing their words. And the Lord reveals himself to the unbelieving disciple not when he is alone with himself, but when he is once again in the community. Every Christian community is this place where not only all good is held in common, as the passage from Acts tells us, but above all where faith is shared and each person supports the faith of the other.



UNA FEDE CONDIVISA

«Voi lo amate, pur senza averlo visto e ora, senza vederlo, credete in lui». Ciò che scrive Pietro nella sua prima lettera esorta ciascuno di noi a vivere la beatitudine della fede che il Risorto proclama dopo essere stato riconosciuto da Tommaso: «Beati quelli che non hanno visto e hanno creduto». Tommaso pretende di vedere personalmente giacché non si fida della testimonianza degli altri e della comunità. Non ha creduto alla parola della Maddalena. La sua assenza, nel primo giorno della settimana, lo attesta: egli non è con gli altri apostoli perché non ha accolto l'annuncio di Maria. Allo stesso modo non crede a ciò che i suoi compagni gli dicevano. C'è qui un verbo all'imperfetto per sottolineare l'insistenza con cui gli altri discepoli gli hanno annunciato il loro incontro con il Risorto, come pure l'ostinazione di Tommaso a non credere alle loro parole. E il Signore si manifesta al discepolo incredulo non quando è solo con sé stesso, ma quando è di nuovo nella comunità. Ogni comunità cristiana è questo luogo in cui non solo ogni bene è in comune, come ci dice la pagina degli Atti, ma dove è soprattutto la fede ad essere condivisa e ciascuno sostiene la fede dell'altro.

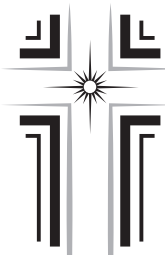
