THE SHEPHERD WALKS
AHEAD OF THE SHEEP

Through the writing of the different evangelists, every Fourth Sunday of Easter the Church's liturgy presents to us the images of the "Shepherd" and the "gate," with which Jesus identifies himself and which represent his identity and mission. The identity: Jesus is the Shepherd, the good one—not only in the sense of feeling, but also in the concrete sense of getting to work (good, that is, active) to save at any cost the sheep of his flock, each one of us! In the biblical image, the Shepherd is the one who does not stop at making proclamations, but gets busy, even facing steep and difficult paths in order to find the lost sheep and bring it back to the safety of the fold, that is, to the love of his presence. The mission: having found the sheep, sometimes bruised or wounded, desolate or disoriented, he leads it, opens wide the door of his mercy, keeps it close to himself, taking care of it. This is why everyone has the good hope of having life, and life in abundance! In this way, each person can remove from themselves the greatest fear that threatens us: feeling alone and abandoned, without a safe refuge.

Nell'immagine biblica, il Pastore è colui che non si ferma a emettere proclami, ma si dà da fare, affrontando anche vie scoscese e impervie pur di trovare la pecora smarrita, e riportarla alla sicurezza dell'ovile, cioè all'amore della sua presenza. La missione: ritrovata la pecora, a volte acciaccata o ferita, desolata o disorientata, egli la conduce, le spalanca la porta della sua misericordia, la trattiene presso di sé, prendendosene cura. Ecco perché, ognuno ha la buona speranza di avere vita, e vita in abbondanza! Ognuno così può eliminare da sé la più grande paura che ci minaccia: sentirsi soli e abbandonati, senza un rifugio sicuro.

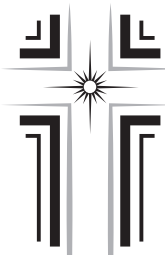
