KNOWING HOW TO CORRECT**BELONGS TO THOSE WHO KNOW HOW TO LOVE**

"If your brother sins..." Jesus places fraternal correction at the heart of community life. It does not arise from the need to be right, but from responsibility for the other, so as not to leave him alone in his error. Even before sin, the relationship comes. The path indicated by Jesus is gradual and delicate: from face-to-face contact, where the word can still save without humiliating, to community involvement, not to crush but always to support and win over the brother. The language is surprising: the brother is a precious asset, which cannot be risked losing, and correction is an act of protection. Everyone must feel the responsibility to be like a sentinel for their brother, watching over him like an angel or a life companion. Those who remain silent out of fear or a desire to live quietly can fall into a lack of love. Those who intervene, however, do so because they cannot resign themselves to the loss of their brother and know that even the most uncomfortable word can become a source of salvation because "charity does no harm to one's neighbor" because it becomes truth without harshness, courage without violence, faithfulness even when it costs.

Il percorso indicato da Gesù è graduale e delicato: dal faccia a faccia, dove la parola può ancora salvare senza umiliare, al coinvolgimento della comunità, non per schiacciare ma sempre per sostenere e guadagnare il fratello. Il linguaggio è sorprendente: il fratello è un bene prezioso, che non si può rischiare di perdere, e la correzione è un atto di custodia. Ognuno deve sentire la responsabilità di essere come sentinella per il fratello per vegliare su di lui come un angelo o un compagno di vita. Chi tace per paura o quieto vivere può cadere nella mancanza di amore, chi, invece, interviene è perché non si rassegna alla perdita del fratello e sa che anche la parola più scomoda può trasformarsi in luogo di salvezza perché «la carità non fa alcun male al prossimo» in quanto diventa verità senza
